

CJHHA Privacy Policy

This policy includes information about the categories of information that the Carolina Junior Hurricanes Hockey Association (“we”) collect, how we use that information, how we share that information, and how you can communicate with us about your information. We may change this policy from time to time. If we make changes, we will notify you by revising the date at the top of the policy.

We collect information you provide to us, which includes registration and payment information; players’ date of birth; safety information such as concussion testing results, and names and contact information of players, coaches, parents and guardians, business contacts, and other individuals who interact with the CJHHA. When you access our website, we may collect additional information about you and your device, including via the use of cookies and other tracking technologies. We do not knowingly collect personal information from children without the consent of their parents or guardians.

We use the information described above to provide CJHHA services as requested, to comply with legal requirements, and to otherwise conduct activities in accordance with our mission. In particular, we use registration and payment information to process applications and payments. We use dates of birth in assignment of players to teams. We use safety information to help ensure player safety and security during CJHHA sponsored and related activities. We use names and contact information for each of the foregoing purposes and other purposes related to operation and improvement of the CJHHA youth hockey programs, including: monitoring compliance with league and residency rules; scheduling practices, games, tournaments and other events; maintaining emergency contact information for players and coaches; and communicating with players, coaches, parents and guardians, business contacts, and other individuals about our hockey programs. In some cases, those communications may be intended to solicit donations or to market, promote, and drive engagement with our hockey programs or associated third party goods and services such as equipment and training.

We may share the information that we collect: with coaches and team managers; with the consent or at the direction of the individual, or in the case of minor players, their parent or guardian; with vendors and service providers who help us provide our youth hockey programs, including payment processors; where necessary with professional advisors including auditors and insurers; and where necessary with others including law enforcement to protect the rights, property, and safety of the CJHHA and the players. We do not sell personal information.
